# Provision in the Desert

Exodus 16

It will be easier to get them out of Egypt than to get Egypt out of them.

### I. By Taking Us into the Wilderness (vs. 1-3) Deuteronomy 8:1-2

A. Shaping the heart

Heart issue: grumbling (vs.2-3)

1) Grumblers make their situation out to be worse than it actually is.

#### Psalm 78:18

2) Grumblers exaggerate the advantages of the past.
3) Grumblers make baseless accusations against good people.
Psalm 78:17

B. Teaching greater dependence on God

We will never learn that God is all we need until God is all we have.

### II. By Showing Us His Provision (vs. 4-18)

A. His <u>gracious</u> provision (vs. 4-10) **Deuteronomy 8:3 There is glory in the ordinary provision and providence of God.**  B. His <u>plentiful</u> provision (vs. 11-15) **Psalm 105:39-40**Manna - "what is it?"
Quail

the timing – they would arrive at the right time
the quantity – covering the ground **Psalm 78:27-28**

C. His <u>perfect</u> provision (vs. 16-18) God gives us not necessarily what we want or expect, but what we need. Proverbs 30:8-9

God's perfect provision for us is Jesus Christ (John 6:30-35)

## III. By Calling Us to Obedience (vs. 19-30)

#### Sanctification is impossible without obedience.

Just like the Israelites with the manna/quail: We must <u>gather it</u> We must <u>prepare it</u> We must <u>eat it</u> **The most critical part of sanctification is obedience. The most critical part of obedience is to obey right away.**
